Notice of Motions

4. Motion from Councillor Mary Bohan

I ask that works be carried out on the Coolegreane Road, close to T. Mc Sharry's house as this is now dangerous because of serious subsidence.

5. Motion from Councillor Mary Bohan

I ask that this Council examine the provision of safety measures in Millbank Lawns estate in Dromahair. Residents are requesting speed ramps and signs for no through road.

6. Motion from Councillor Padraig Fallon

I ask that an examination of the green area beside No. 54 and opposite No. 55 Drumlease Dromahair be undertaken with a view to turning it into a parking and turning area for estate residents.

7. Motion from Councillor Padraig Fallon

I am asking for an update with regard to the taking in charge of Windmill Park estate, Drumkeeran.

8. Motion from Councillor Felim Gurn

There was a great response from fire services and Leitrim County Council staff to alleviate the excessive water from buildings that were flooded in Manorhamilton at the end of May this year due to excessive downpours. However there was excessive flooding at the Bee Park and New line in Manorhamilton. It appears to be the case that the rain water drains had not been checked for months with excessive dirt and leaves building up in them, I believe this needs to be checked on a monthly basis in all areas of the town of Manorhamilton. I ask this Municipal to call on the OPW to give dedicated funding to get trees cleared that after over grown in the Owenbeg River at the back of Bee Park Community Centre, these need to be cleared from the back of Garda Station to MCI to the Bee Park so that water can get away and not cause future flooding.

9. Motion from Councillor Justin Warnock

With the removal of the Hidden Heartlands promotional sign from near Kinlough, I ask Leitrim County Council a) what collaboration has taken place between the Council and Failte Ireland in relation to redrawing the boundaries of the Hidden Heartlands in the Manorhamilton

MD.

b) what promotional work will be carried out now by Failte Ireland to promote North Leitrim on the Wild Atlantic Way.

10. Motion from Councillor Justin Warnock

I ask the Planning Department for an updated list of the estates which have requested to be taken in charge and which are currently being progressed in the Manorhamilton MD.

11. Motion from Councillor James Gilmartin

I ask Manorhamilton Municipal District to provide a pedestrian crossing in the vicinity of the new library in Dromahair. This would have the dual benefit of facilitating pedestrians to cross alongside providing traffic calming/safety measures on the main street.

12. Motion from Councillor James Gilmartin

I ask the area engineer if traffic calming measures can be introduced on the Creamery Road approach into Manorhamilton. There is a lot of traffic exiting and entering on to this section of road which is very dangerous.

13. Motion from Councillor Eddie Mitchell

I ask Leitrim County Council to look at the traffic flow through Kiltyclogher and consider introducing some physical features along the road to encourage drivers to reduce speed as they pass through the village.

14. Motion from Councillor Eddie Mitchell

Following the successful completion of public realm works in Manorhamilton I ask that the County Council carry out a review of parking facilities for people with disabilities including buses providing special services operating within the town.
