Notice of Motions

4. Motion from Councillor Des Guckian:

That we oppose the placing of the line of the new Bypass road of Carrick-on-Shannon within 50m of any house in Glas na hAbhainn Estate and demand that it be kept over 100m away from the nearest house there.

5. Motion from Councillor Des Guckian:

That several new lay-bys be placed along the narrow L5547 road from Gortfadda towards Aghalilfaughna, particularly towards the top of the hill, where the sight-lines are bad and the margins are soft and steep. This is a very busy road. Reversing downhill in such an area and in such conditions is dangerous.

6. Motion from Councillor Sean McGowan:

That we call on the management of the Local Link bus service in Leitrim to expand the daily route serving Mohill-Dromod onto Carrick on Shannon to include in the village of Roosky as part of its route. The people of Roosky are angry, as there is very little Local Link service available to the community.

7. Motion from Councillor Sean McGowan:

I ask, Mr. Darragh O'Boyle, District Engineer Carrick-on-Shannon MD, to immediately put in place a programme of works to cut back the heavy vegetation/foilage at the junctions where local roads are exiting onto busy local & regional roads in the Carrick on Shannon Municipal District, in the interest of public safety.

8. Motion from Councillor Paddy Farrell:

I call on Leitrim County Council to seek funding to provide a public playground in Leitrim Village for young children.

9. Motion from Councillor Paddy Farrell:

There is major concern about the speed of traffic going through our villages in the Carrick-on-Shannon Municipal District. I have received several complaints from Leitrim Village, Rooskey and Dromod about this serious issue that the Council needs to address.

10. Motion from Councillor Cormac Flynn:

I ask that Leitrim County Council, in consultation with Úisce Éireann, expedite resurfacing and widening works on road L3409 (Kiltoghert/Gowel/Kilnagross) as a matter of urgency.

11. Motion from Councillor Cormac Flynn:

I ask that Leitrim County Council investigate the possibility of traffic calming measures at

Jamestown Village, with the inclusion of a pedestrian crossing at Jamestown Church/Community Centre, which is also the location of a childcare facility.

12. Motion from Councillor Maeve Reynolds:

Can I enquire about any current or future development plans for the two-story car park located at Carrick Business Campus. Given its ideal location, I believe it holds great potential for transformation into an outdoor recreational facility, which could benefit the community significantly.

13. Motion from Councillor Maeve Reynolds:

I call on Leitrim County Council to address the safety at pedestrian crossings beside schools, particularly at St. Manchan's National School, Mohill, and also at St. Joseph's National School in Leitrim Village.

Could the council consider appointing a school warden as a solution to these unsafe crossing situations, while also promoting more walking to school?
