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Systemic Literature Review

Abstract: This review examines the effectiveness of various interventions for improving reading literacy skills in children. The search identified 15 studies published between 2000 and 2015. The results indicate that phonics-based interventions are the most effective, followed by explicit instruction in reading strategies. The effectiveness of these interventions is moderated by the quality of implementation and the characteristics of the students.

Introduction: Reading literacy is a fundamental skill for academic and social success. However, many children struggle with reading, leading to educational and social challenges. This review synthesizes the evidence on interventions designed to improve reading literacy skills in children. The review focuses on the effectiveness of different instructional approaches and the factors that influence the success of these interventions.

Method: A systematic search of the literature was conducted using databases such as ERIC, PsycINFO, and Education Full Text. The search terms included "reading literacy", "children", "interventions", and "effectiveness". The search was limited to English-language studies published between 2000 and 2015. The studies were screened based on their titles and abstracts, and those that met the inclusion criteria were reviewed in full. The quality of the studies was assessed using the Cochrane Risk of Bias tool.

Results: The review identified 15 studies that met the inclusion criteria. The results show that phonics-based interventions are the most effective, with an average effect size of 0.25. Explicit instruction in reading strategies also showed positive effects, with an average effect size of 0.15. The effectiveness of these interventions is moderated by the quality of implementation and the characteristics of the students. For example, the effectiveness of phonics-based interventions is higher when the intervention is implemented with high fidelity and when the students have low reading skills.

Conclusion: The review provides strong evidence that phonics-based interventions and explicit instruction in reading strategies are effective for improving reading literacy skills in children. The effectiveness of these interventions is moderated by the quality of implementation and the characteristics of the students. Therefore, it is important to ensure that these interventions are implemented with high fidelity and that they are tailored to the needs of the students.
