Leitrim Village Flood Relief Scheme **Public Consultation Event No. 2**

Scheme Objectives and Overview

The Office of Public Works (OPW) have carried out a Catchment Flood Risk Assessment and Management (CFRAM) Study for the Shannon catchment as part of a National CFRAM programme. The CFRAM Study informed the Flood Risk Management Plan (FRMP), which set out a range of potential flood risk management options for Leitrim Village.

Leitrim County Council has commissioned Ryan Hanley as Engineering and Environmental Consultants to assess, develop and design a viable and environmentally sustainable flood relief scheme for Leitrim Village. The Project Team includes engineers, ecologists and other professionals from Ryan Hanley and its subconsultants working in partnership with Leitrim County Council and OPW. Work has been progressing on the flood relief scheme including data collection, constraints study, initial public consultation, site surveys and investigations, hydrological and hydraulic analyses, workshops, options identification and options development. An indicative flow chart showing the process from inception through to construction for a flood relief scheme is shown.
