Declaration regarding Development/Exempted Development (Section 5 of Planning & Development Act 2000, as amended)

WHEREAS a question has arisen as to whether the construction of 3 No. 100m² classrooms and 1 No. 50m² classroom in modular build for a duration of 5 years constitutes development which is exempted development

AND WHEREAS the said question was referred to Leitrim County Council by MSLETB Carrigallen Vocational School, Declan Conboy, C/O Davitt, on the 6th of February 2024,

AND WHEREAS Leitrim County Council, in considering this referral, had regard particularly to -

- (a) Section 2(1), 3(1) and 4(2) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended)
- (b) Article 6 (1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)
- (c) Article 9 (1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)
- (d) Schedule 2, Part 1, Class 20D of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)

AND WHEREAS Leitrim County Council has concluded that –

• The construction of 3 No. 100m² classrooms and 1 No. 50m² classroom in modular build for a duration of 5 years on the grounds of Carrigallen Vocational School constitutes development and such development is <u>not</u> exempted development.

NOW THEREFORE Leitrim County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 5(2)(a) of the 2000 Act, as amended, hereby declares that:

- The construction of 3 No. 100m² classrooms and 1 No. 50m² classroom in modular build for a duration of 5 years on the grounds of Carrigallen Vocational School constitutes development and such development is **not exempted development**.
- You are further advised that the temporary ten-year period for permission Ref P.10/97 for the 'prefabricated school science laboratory and a prefabricated classroom' expired on 03/11/2020 and these existing prefabs are, therefore, unauthorised.
