WHEREAS a question has arisen as to whether the construction of a proposed agricultural storage shed is Development or is not Development and whether it is or is not Exempted Development at Cloonty, Ballintrillick, Co. Leitrim constitutes development which **is** exempted development.

AND WHEREAS the said question was referred to Leitrim County Council by the Christopher Connolly on the 12th March 2024

AND WHEREAS Leitrim County Council, in considering this referral, had regard particularly to -

- (a) Section 2(1), 3(1) and 4(1) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended)
- (b) Article 6 (1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)
- (c) Article 9 (1)(a) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)
- (d) Class 9 of Schedule 2, Part 3 of Exempted Development *Agricultural Structures* of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)

AND WHEREAS Leitrim County Council has concluded that -

the construction of a proposed agricultural storage shed is Development and is Exempted Development at Cloonty, Ballintrillick, Co. Leitrim on the basis that it does satisfy all the conditions and limitations associated with Class 9 of Schedule 2 - Part 3, Exempted Development – Rural.

NOW THEREFORE Leitrim County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 5(2)(a) of the 2000 Act, as amended, hereby declares that:

• The construction of a proposed agricultural storage shed at Cloonty, Ballintrillick, Co. Leitrim constitutes development which is **exempted development**.
